20mph limits are areas where the speed limit has been reduced to 20mph but there are no physical measures to reduce vehicle speeds. 20mph speed limit signs are used to notify the driver of the speed limit in the area. It is vital that 20mph signage is clear and if necessary, repeaters used at appropriate intervals to ensure that drivers

The organisation pointed out that the study said the 20 mph limits caused “no significant change in the short term in collisions and casualties”, and the reduction in median speed after the introduction of lower limits was just 0.7mph in residential areas and 0.9mph in city centre areas.

Depending on whether they need new infrastructure to curb speed, some streets will be set as 20mph zones and some will have 20mph limits. As part of the Safer Routes to School initiative, 20mph zones will be set around schools in Stirling – some as part-time, in accordance with the school day, and some as permanent.
