Checklist: Disease Management Before growing a crop, clear the greenhouse of plant debris, weeds, flats and tools. Wash and disinfect empty benches, potting tables, storage shelves, tools and pots. After the greenhouse has been sanitized, avoid recontamination with pathogens. Purchase seeds, bulbs and cuttings from reliable sources. Use culture-indexed cuttings, if available, to reduce the ...

Bacteria such as *Erwinia chrysanthemi*, fungi such as *Botrytis* and *Pythium*, foliar nematodes (*Aphelenchoides*), and tobacco mosaic virus, survive for months in plant debris.
