Medieval Ireland Another consequence of Ireland's isolation from Romanized Europe was the development of a distinctive Celtic type of Christianity. Saint Patrick introduced mainstream Latin Christianity into the country in the 5th century AD, but the system of bishops with territorial dioceses, modelled on the Roman Empire's administrative system, did not take secure root in Ireland at this time.
