Focused Neurological Assessment - RN.com

- It is challenging to do a "good" neurological assessment on all patients.
- Disadvantage is that little of the exam is possible -Advantage is that you can follow the exam over time. "Traditions and Assumptions"
- GCS is not a surrogate for a neurological exam.
- Delirium monitoring is also not as good neurological exam.

Neurological. Cranial Nerves: Olfaction

(I) intact by identifying the smell of coffee grounds. Visual acuity (II) is good bilaterally with 20/20 vision on hand-held chart (while wearing his corrective lenses). Overall, a neuro exam may consist of the following: Mental Status; Cranial Nerves; Motor Exam; Reflexes; Sensory Exam; Coordination; Gait; Sample Basic Normal Exam Documentation.

Documentation of a basic, normal neuro exam should look something along the lines of the following: The patient is alert and oriented to person, place, and time with normal speech.

Assessment Pupils are another important component of the neuro exam. Assessing them is especially important in a patient with impaired LOC. Like a change in LOC, a change in pupil size, shape, or reactivity can indicate increasing intracranial pressure (ICP) from a mass or fluid.⁷ We'll cover pupils as part of the cranial nerve assessment.

Assessment: In summary, the patient is a 50-year-old woman with longstanding headaches who has had an acute onset of pupil-sparing partial third nerve palsy on the right (involving levator palpebrae, superior rectus, and medial rectus) associated with a bifrontal headache.
