prince: In this work princeipie isn't a title and doesn't desig-nate a rank; it stands for any ruler of a state, whether a king or queen or duke or count etc. The English word 'prince' also had that broad meaning once (Queen Elizabeth I referred to herself as a 'prince'), and it seems the best word to use here.
