On the positive side, students found wikis useful for arranging information and sharing knowledge, while instructors thought wikis made managing and marking group work easier and more effective. Other issues related to using wikis as a collaborative learning tool in higher education are also considered.

Nuclino is a real-time wiki for team collaboration. Wikidot is a social networking service and wiki hosting service suitable for both public and private wikis.
