- The Regional Trial Court designated as a Family Court shall have original and exclusive jurisdiction over cases of violence against women and their children under this law. In the absence of such court in the place where the offense was committed, the case shall be filed in the Regional Trial Court where the crime or any of its elements was committed at the option of the compliant.

Equal Under the Law: Married Women's Property Acts in the...

Women married under the [Marriage] Act have their property rights protected by the Act, thereby making them entitled to a share in the marital property, including the husbands' property, and the jointly owned and acquired property. While women married under customary law have little or no rights over their spouse's property.

Under this law, no discrimination is permissible in recruitment and service conditions except where employment of women is prohibited or restricted by the law. The situation regarding enforcement of the provisions of this law is regularly monitored by the Central Ministry of Labour and the Central Advisory Committee.
